Did You Know...?

Those international scholars on J-1 visa:

Prior to leaving the U.S., make sure that you (and any family members) have a valid travel signature on your DS-2019. You may obtain a new travel signature by visiting ISSA in 105 Main Building. To re-enter the U.S. you (and family members in J-2 status) must have a valid passport, DS-2019, and visa. If you will be traveling to somewhere other than your home country, make sure you consult the website for your embassy or consulate or destination to make sure you understand the visa and entry requirements.
